- 3. Very disappointed in the college's connections with the community. I grew up attending events and seeing the college's interfaces with the people in the community but now you are very isolated.
- 4. The college needs to build relationships with the community not build fences.
- 5. The college has lost its community agricultural resource. It has become isolated.
- 6. I used to run on the cross country track. It is sad that the college has closed the running trails.
- 7. You have closed up the gardens and the connections to your neighbors.
- 8. The board asked that these issues be addressed and that we bring the revised mission statement back to the WHWCNC when it has been revised.
