## ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS (BR 6201)

### **Unit Requirement**

- •60 units
- Minimum of 18 units within the major or area of emphasis

#### Residency Requirement

•12 unit residency requirement at LA Pierce to earn a degree

### **Scholarship Requirement**

- 2.0 GPA average
- •"C" or better or "Pass" for major requirements

## ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS (BR 6201)

#### Conferring the degree when offered at multiples LACCD colleges

- •When the same major is offered at multiple colleges in LACCD, the degree shall be conferred where the student has taken the majority (50% or more)
- •If equally split, Pierce will award the degree

#### **General Education Requirement (local degrees)**

- •LA Pierce GE Plan, CSU GE Plan or IGETC
- •Area E1 will be waived for Nursing and other high unit majors over 39 units (ex. Pre-Vet)
- •Additionally, varied forms of the CSU and IGETC CSU GE for STEM or IGETC for STEM may be used for local degrees

  GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIRED COURSES

Students must complete one of the following General Education Plans:

# ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS — WHAT TO LOOK FOR

1) 12 units minimum for residency completed at LA Pierce

- 2) Check that students have the correct minimum units for the specific degree type (i.e. ADT = 60 CSU transferable units; AA degree = 60 degree applicable units)
- 3) Make sure the student has a 2.0 GPA for specific degree type (ADT or AA/S)

## CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT (BR 6202)

### **Residency Requirement**

 $\bullet 1/5$  of units (20%) must be completed at LA Pierce

12 units = 2.4 units

15 units = 3 units

### **Scholarship Requirement**

"C" or better or "Pass" for all courses

Exception: CSU GE Certificate of Achievement

## CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT (BR 6200)

### Conferring the Certificate when offered at multiple LACCD Colleges

- •When the same major is offered at multiple colleges in LACCD, the degree shall be conferred where the student has taken the majority (50% or more)
- •If equally split, Pierce will award the degree
- •CSU GE and IGETC are exempt the college that certifies completion may award the Certificate of Achievement

#### **Automatic Awarding of Certificates of Achievement**

Certificates will be automatically awarded for Certificates of Achievement who have completed the degree requirements <u>if</u> the requirements for the Certificate are met by the degree

# CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT REQUIREMENTS — WHAT TO LOOK FOR

1) Check that students have completed 1/5 residency at LA Pierce

2) Make sure the student has a "C" or "Pass" or better for all courses

# CATALOG RIGHTS (BR 6203)

**CATALOG YEAR:** Fall semester through the next summer

<u>CONTINUOUS ATTENDANCE</u>: no more than one Fall or Spring semester missed within a school year (excludes Summer and Winter Intersessions)

Exception: Military withdrawals or grades of "EW" are considered continuous attendance

# CATALOG RIGHTS (BR 6203)

A student remaining in continuous attendance in the Los Angeles Community College District may elect to satisfy the degree, certificate or graduation requirements in effect at the college from which the student will either earn his/her degree, certificate or graduate (Pierce):

- 1. at the time the student began such attendance at the college, or
- 2. at the time all graduation requirements are met, or
- 3. any intervening catalog term between the time the student began continuous attendance and the time all graduation requirements were met.

# CATALOG RIGHTS (BR 6203)

A student who no longer maintains catalog rights may apply for a certificate or degree that was completed while s/he maintained catalog rights. This will be awarded in the current term.

## ADDITIONAL ASSOCIATE DEGREES (BR 6205)

Students who have **already earned** an AA/AS degree or higher from a U.S. regionally accredited institution will be granted an AA/AS degree when the following requirements are met:

- 1) Complete scholarship, residency, GE and major requirements
- 2) Local AA/AS degrees complete 6 units in the major at LA Pierce College.

These units do **not** need to be NEW units after the first degree was awarded.

Exception: ADTs have no major unit minimum

- 3) Major courses for previous degrees may be used again for additional degrees
- 4) Courses for the major or area of emphasis must have a "C" or "Pass"
- 5) No limit to the number of additional degrees awarded if the requirements are met

# ADDITIONAL ASSOCIATE DEGREES — LA PIERCE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE 05/14/2010

Policy on general education fulfillment for students with prior degree:

Local Los Angeles Community College District associate degree general education requirements are fully satisfied by students who have an Associate, Baccalaureate or higher degree from a United States regionally accredited institution.

### **CONCURRENT DEGREES**

Concurrent degrees are awarded in the **same** semester. Students may petition for concurrent degrees if the following criteria is met:

- 1) Complete scholarship, residency, competency, general education and major requirements
- 2) No maximum number of concurrent degrees
- 3) Courses used for major requirements may be applied towards the completion of concurrent degrees
- 4) Completion of a GE plan for one degree will fulfill the GE plan for concurrent degrees. If there is a different GE plan then that GE plan must be fulfilled.
- 5) Courses for the major or area of emphasis must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass"
