# Took Classes Outside of LACCD (in a foreign country)

"I have taken classes at a college/university in a foreign country and would like to use those credits toward my education goal."

If the college/university at which you have taken courses is a U.S. regionally accredited institution, we may use these courses to grant you degrees/certificates at Los Angeles Pierce College and toward transfer general education (IGETC and/or CSU GE). If the courses you have taken are NOT from a U.S. regionally accredited institution, we can only use them to grant you local degrees/certificates from LAPC. We cannot use them toward transfer general education (CSU GE and/or IGETC) or transfer degrees. To use courses from a foreign non-U.S. regionally accredited institution toward local LAPC degrees/certificates, you must have the foreign transcript evaluated using one of the approved credential evaluation agencies and request a detailed equivalency report that includes course title, semester units, equivalency, and letter grade earned. Course descriptions provided by the approved credential evaluationagency are required for any courses needed for major-related requirements.

If you have already earned a bachelor's degree (or higher) in a different country and are planning to pursue a second bachelor's degree, be mindful that not all universities allow admission to students who are pursuing a second bachelor's degree. You must connect with <u>representatives</u> from each university to which you plan to apply to learn if you will be considered a student with a "second bachelor's degree" and if they will admit you under this condition. Many students who have already earned a bachelor's degree from abroad continue their education in the U.S. by ar
